- #1a: The Seminary Student Tuition Assistant Matching Grant** **\$15,000.00**
- The LCMS Joint Seminary Fund and LCMS Board of Pastoral Education, St. Louis, MO
Assist students preparing for the Pastoral Ministry of the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod at Concordia Seminary (St. Louis, MO) and Concordia Theological Seminary (Ft. Wayne, IN) by providing matching assistance.
- #1b: Technology for Winnebago Lutheran Elementary** **\$2,500.00**
- Jesus Our Savior Lutheran School, Winnebago, Nebraska
Funds will be used to purchase two desktop computers, one laptop computer, one projector, two computer desks, software and peripherals needed to bring the school up to date.
- #3a: His Kids Camps Scholarship Fund** **\$6,000.00**
- Camp Luther, Schuyler, Nebraska
Camp Luther's ministry to those with Special Needs (physical and mental) is growing each year to now include 3 weeks of summer camp and two weekend retreats. Funding will cover camperships for those with Special Needs and help fund the cost of the many volunteers who come to serve as "Buddies".
- #3b: Catechisms for Sudan** **\$7,500.00**
- Lutheran Heritage Foundation, Macomb, Michigan
Missionaries and evangelists throughout Sudan rely on *Luther's Small Catechism* to provide a simple but thorough explanation of Scripture in Zande and Nuer languages, but the supply is now exhausted. Lutheran churches in Sudan have asked reprints in these languages, and to translate and publish the book in the Dinke language.
- #3c: Early Childhood Mental Health Therapies** **\$14,400.00**
- Center for Healthy Families, Omaha, Nebraska
The Center for Healthy Families in North Omaha will provide Early Childhood Mental Health Therapies and other comprehensive services to assist children and their parents to alter unhealthy behaviors. The Center provides incentives to parents, via their participation in activities that earn them points to "purchase" new or gently used items at no cost.
- #6: Vehicle for Missionaries** **\$10,000.00**
- Lutheran Bible Translators, Aurora, Illinois
Funding will help purchase a reliable vehicle for Lutheran Bible Translator missionaries working in the field. Reliable, durable vehicles are an absolute necessity. The cost of purchasing vehicles in Africa often includes transporting them from other countries and averages \$40,000 per vehicle. This proposal requests a portion of that amount.
- #7: Trinity/HOPE** **(partial payment)** **\$1,100.00**

At Lutheran schools in Haiti, the children are told of the Good News, shown Christian love, and given a nutritious meal each day. This grant would be used to feed 100 children in the coming school year.
